...PROUDLY TELL PEOPLE WHAT YOU DO

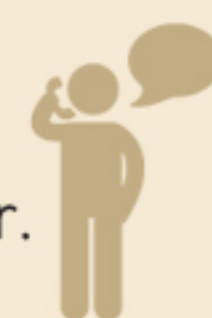
When someone asks you what you do for a living, you tell them straight-up with a satisfied smile on your face.
